





FÉVRIER BIENVENUE À LA VILLE DE QUÉBEC!

Chenonceau, the second most-visited castle in France, spans over the river Cher in the Loire River Valley and has medieval and Renaissance features. This castle is sometimes named "the château of six ladies" due to the influence of six women who resided here over the centuries, including Queen Catherine de Medici and Diane de Poitiers. Both of these women created lush gardens on either side of the entrance. This spectacular castle was a military hospital during World War II and is now privately owned but open for visitors to enjoy its castle, gardens and even a maze on the property of the château.

They were baked by the king's baker in the form of a smile to cheer up the young bride, Princesse Jeanne de Laval who was unhappy to marry the much older King Rene d'Anjou. These treats are made of crushed almonds, candied fruits, and sweetened with honey, melons and oranges. Try one yourself and you too will be smiling when walking around the beautiful town of Aix!







The city of Bordeaux has been around for over 2,000 years and has been influenced by the Romans, the British and of course the French. This city is not only known for its wine industry but also its beautiful "old city area" where you can find museums, parks, and preserved buildings which date from the 1400s. While enjoying a stroll in the old city, be sure to pick up a "canelé de Bordeaux." These small cakes are baked in a candle-shaped mold, which creates a crunchy caramel outside and a rich custard-like inside. Legend has it that these desserts were the invention of thrifty bakers, who used left-over egg yolks from the wineries who had used the egg whites to clarify their wines. Legend or not, these treats are worth trying! Bon Appétit!

Mont Saint Michel, a rocky islet between the regions of Brittany and Normandy, was built between the 11th and 16th centuries. The church on the top of the islet is dedicated to Saint Michel, who supposedly came to Bishop Aubert of Avranches in a dream and told him to build a church. The bishop ignored Saint Michel until one morning he woke up with a burnt hole in his skull from the finger of Saint Michel, who was obviously serious about having a church in his honor! Today it is visited by over 2.5 million people yearly.



Louis XIV "Le Roi Soleil" took the throne at the young age of 4; during his long reign (which was the longest in French history), he built the château of Versailles which would become the center of his monarchy. 


