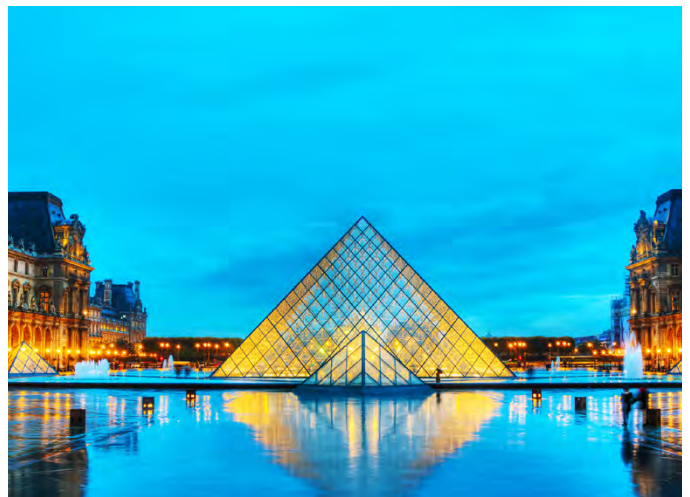
Showcasing the rich history of French-speaking nations

Language Immersion in France

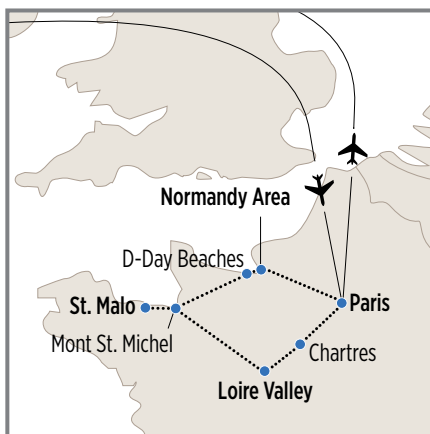
9 Days | Overnights: Nice (3), Paris (4)

Le Mistral

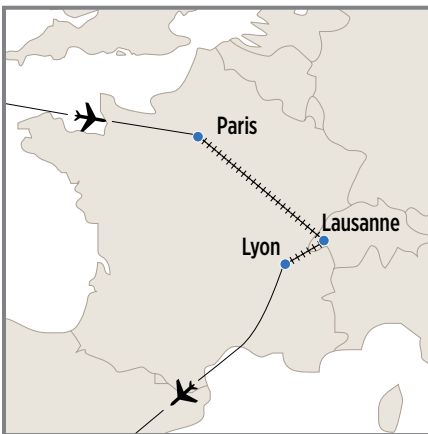

At any point up to 45 days prior to departure, ACIS Group Leaders may move their tour if they are uncomfortable traveling to their destination at that time.
